Forty years ago BG&RM Williams Electrical began maintaining 30 traffic signal sites across VicRoads' Northern Region (now the Loddon Mallee Region).

From small beginnings with two employees the business grew and built a reputation for pride in their work and a dedication to local community. In 2021 the business merged with UCS to become UCS Signals.

We are now a team of 18 who know every nut and bolt on the 243 sites we now maintain between Manangatang and Macedon.

In 2025 we proudly celebrate 40 years of continuously supporting VicRoads and the Department of Transport and Planning in our no-fuss country style.



Transitioning from BG & RM Williams to UCS Signals in 2021 marked a new chapter of expansion and expertise. Today UCS Signals has grown to 18 employees, and is reinvesting in the industry with three signal technicians undertaking apprenticeships in Bendigo.

Now employing more than 170 Victorians with a strong apprentice program of 40 employees, UCS remains deeply grounded in regional Victoria, with strong partnerships at our core. Our constructive relationship with the ETU, State-wide utility accreditation, client partnership with VicRoads and our connection with employees and their families in Bendigo, Truganina, Pakenham and Mickleham combine to energise communities and power our progress into the future.

As a family business, we believe in supporting the families and small businesses in our regional communities. We live where we work, employ local people, spend locally and keep our dollars moving around the local economy.










ILLUMINATING MILESTONES


As we maintain and innovate across 243 sites, our journey continues, trusted to deliver and driven by a commitment to safeguard and serve the Victorian community.
